



Slat Mill Pre-Session Information

Helping your dog move better, feel better, and live longer

Please read the following carefully before attending.

✓ Location & Setup

I bring the **Slat Mill directly to you**. All I require is a **flat, safe parking space** for the long-wheelbase (LWB) van at your home or a nearby location.

✓ Before Your Session

- Please do not feed your dog for at least **2 hours** before their session.
- Ensure your dog's nails are trimmed to help provide good grip and reduce the risk of injury
- Please toilet your dog **5–10 minutes** before the session.
- You must advise Leadership K9 Training before your appointment if your dog has any medical, injuries, mobility issues, medications, behavioural concerns, or requires any special adjustments.
- Female dogs in season are unable to use the Slat Mill due to hygiene and safety reasons. This generally lasts around **4 weeks**. Please reschedule any sessions during this time..

✓ What to Bring

- If your dog's favourite treats or toys, please have them available.
- You're welcome to use your own **Y-style harness**, please have it fitted before I arrive so we can begin promptly. If required, I carry a range of harnesses suitable for most dogs.

✓ Health & Safety

- It is the owner's responsibility to ensure their dog is healthy and fit enough to participate in physical exercise.
- If you have any concerns regarding your dog's health or suitability, please seek advice from your veterinarian before your appointment.
- Leadership K9 Training is **not** a veterinary service and does not diagnose, treat, or provide veterinary or medical advice.
- Sessions may be shortened, modified, postponed, or stopped at any time if believe it is in the best interests of your dog's health, safety, or welfare.
- Please advise before your appointment if your dog is reactive, anxious, fearful, or has any behavioural concerns to ensure a safe and controlled environment.
- Dogs must remain on lead and under the owner's control unless otherwise instructed.

✓ Weather Policy

The mobile training van is fully enclosed and equipped with air conditioning, making sessions comfortable during hot, cold, or wet weather. In the event of extreme weather, or any conditions considered unsafe, sessions may postpone or reschedule.

✓ Waiver & Consent

By booking or attending a Slat Mill session with Leadership K9 Training, you confirm that you have read and agree to all of the above terms and conditions and understand that participation carries inherent risks.

Leadership K9 Training is not liable for any injury, illness, loss, damage, or complications occurring before, during, or after the session, including those relating to pre-existing, undisclosed, or unknown medical or behavioural conditions. The owner accepts responsibility for all veterinary and associated costs.
